

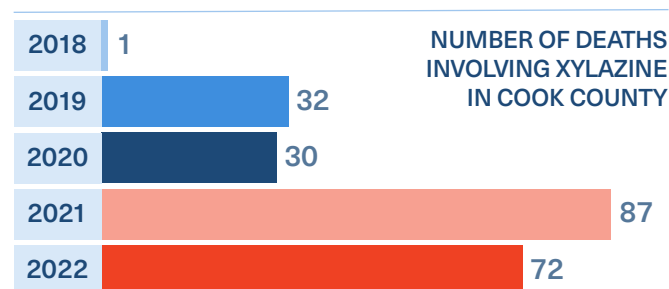
# Xylazine | Tranq



**Tranq** is a veterinary tranquilizer that is added to fentanyl or other opioids to make them last longer.

## Why is it important to know Tranq?

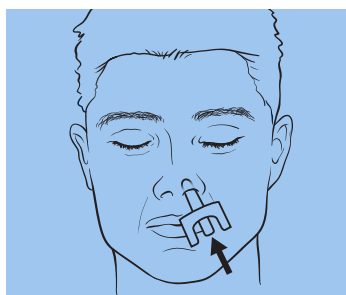
The chance of overdose increases significantly when Tranq is mixed with other drugs (like fentanyl, heroin, benzos).



## What are the effects of Tranq?

- Causes heavy sedation/heavy nod
- Lowers heart rate, blood pressure, and breathing
- Creates feelings of dizziness, tiredness, weakness or confusion
- Lasts more than 4 hours
- Produces severe wounds

## What to do in case of Tranq involved overdose:



**Give naloxone (Narcan)**



**Call 911**



**Put in recovery position**



**Optional: attempt CPR**

**NOTE:** Tranq does not respond to naloxone (Narcan), but it can reverse the effects of the opioid (e.g., fentanyl, heroin, benzos) involved in the overdose.
