## WHO IS MOST AT-RISK FOR SEVERE COVID-19?

### Anyone:

- 65 years old or older
- overweight/obese (BMI >25 or ≥ 30)
- who is immunocompromised
- who smokes or previously smoked
- who is pregnant

### Anyone with:

- Cancer
- Chronic Kidney Disease
- Chronic Liver Disease
- Chronic Lung Disease
- Dementia/Neurodegenerative Disorders
- Diabetes
- Down's Syndrome
- Heart Disease
- HIV
- Mental Health Conditions
- Sickle Cell Disease/Thalassemia
- Solid Organ or Stem Cell Transplant
- Substance Use Disorders
- Tuberculosis

If you test positive for COVID-19 and have one or more health conditions that increase your risk of becoming very sick, treatment may be available. Contact a health professional right away after a positive test to determine if you may be eligible for treatment, even if your symptoms are mild right now.
