PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- Own or rent a single-family home or a 2-4-unit multi-family building
- Home must be in suburban Cook County
- Home must be built before 1978
- A child under the age of six must live in, or frequently visit, the home
- Meet income requirements. For example, a family of four must have an income below \$125,040 a year to be eligible. Full income eligibility requirements can be found at our website or through our QR code below.
