

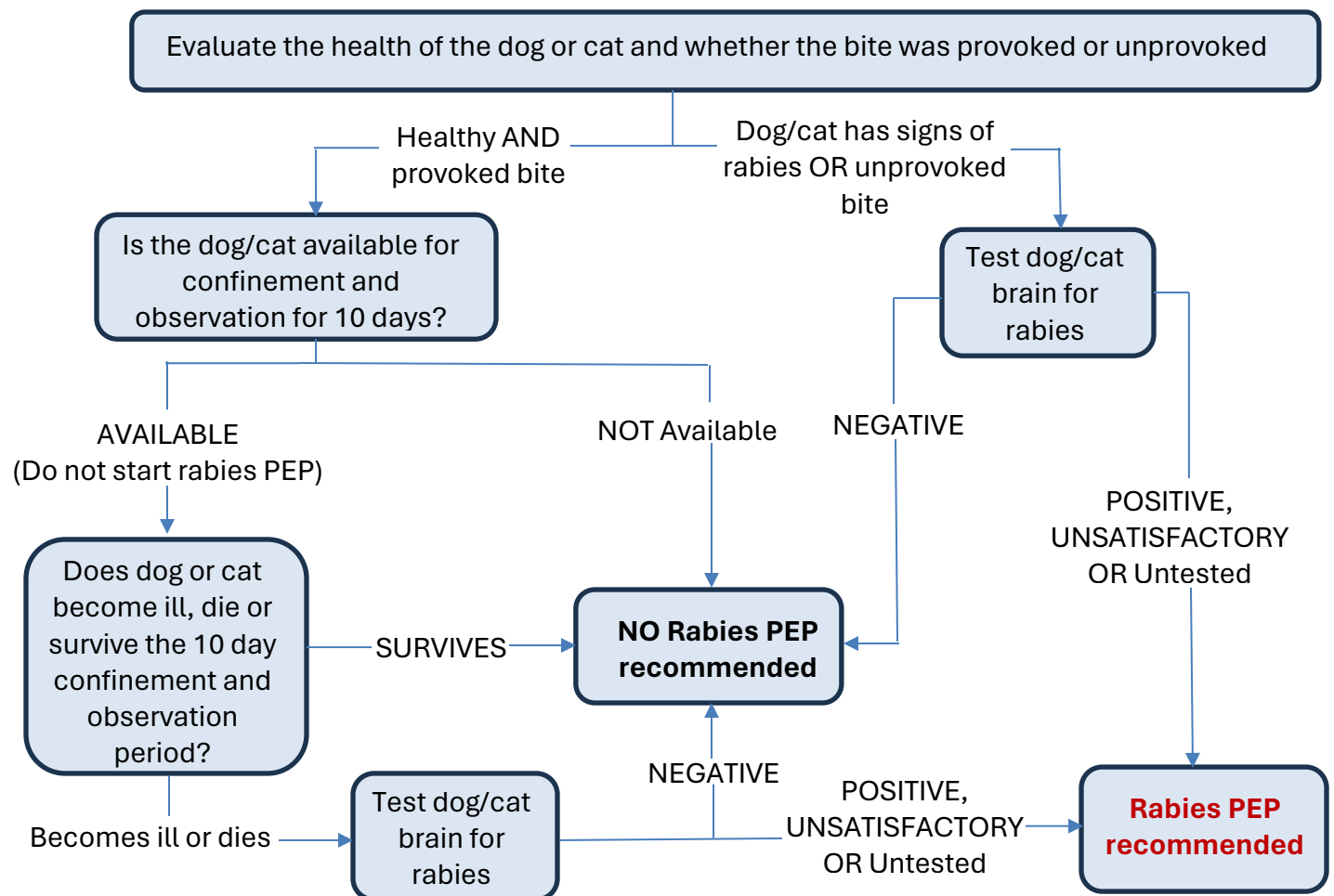


Dog or cat bite that took place in Illinois

Provoked bite – bite might be expected given the circumstances (e.g. separating two fighting animals, handling an injured animal, handling an unfamiliar animal, taking away an animal's food, running or biking by the dog, entering a dog's property)

Unprovoked bite – bite would not be expected given the circumstances (e.g. person walking in the park and dog or cat runs up and bites)

Signs of rabies – trouble walking, paralysis or weakness, excess salivation, neurologic problems or extreme aggression
